The Museum of Contemporary Canadian Art is located on the north side of Queen St W. To find our front entrance, proceed through the metal gates to the back of the courtyard.

Directions by Public Transit

There are several different routes you can take to visit MOCCA using Toronto's public transit system (TTC).

From the East:

Exit at the Queen St Subway Station (Young-University-Spadina Line) and board the 501 streetcar westbound, exiting at Shaw St.

From the West:

Exit at the Osgoode Subway Station (Young-University-Spadina Line) and board the 501 streetcar eastbound, exiting at Shaw St.

or

Exit at the Ossington Subway Station (Bloor-Danforth Line) and board the 63 (to King St) bus southbound. The 63 bus will turn directly onto Queen St W, and you should exit at the Shaw St stop.

Parking

There is pay-parking outside of the Museum on Queen St W and along Shaw St. There are two paid parking lots in the vicinity: across from MOCCA on the south side of Queen St on the grounds of the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, (CAMH), and at a public parking lot north of Queen St on the west side of Ossington St.
